What is Eating Recovery Center Denver Family Days?

Family Days is an in-person, two-day event offered every month in Denver, Colorado. This event is for the education and care of all family members, caregivers and support people who have a loved one in treatment for an eating disorder at Eating Recovery Center (ERC). There is no cost to attend. Attendees are responsible for their own travel, transportation, meals and lodging.

Who should attend?

All family members, caregivers and support people of ERC patients can attend Family Days. Programming material is recommended for ages 16 and older. Families may participate as often as they would like, even after a loved one has left treatment. Please note that space is limited each month, and we ask that attendees RSVP.

Why attend Family Days?

Family Days is an invaluable opportunity to learn about and be involved in the treatment and recovery process. We believe in our patients' capacity to recover and know family is critically important in this process. Through group experiences led by our dynamic treatment team members, participants will:

- Meet with ERC teammates and members of your loved one's treatment team.
- Onnect with other families and support people who can empathize with your experience.
- Learn how to better communicate and support your loved one.
- Deepen your understanding about the treatment and recovery journey.
- Feel empowered by knowledge, resources, connection and encouragement.
- Restore your hope!

We hope that, by the end of Family Days, you will have gained caregiver skills and feel empowered to support your loved one's treatment and recovery journey.

Family Days programming is on the second Thursday and Friday of every month.
